ORDER


This matter comes before the Court on a petition to transfer Charles Ford Galbreath's, BPR No. 2779, license to practice law to Disability Inactive Status pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 21. Medical evidence has been provided that Mr. Galbreath suffers from a medical condition which incapacitates him from continuing the practice of law.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Charles Ford Galbreath's license to practice law is hereby transferred to disability inactive status pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 21. It is further ORDERED that Mr. Galbreath's license to practice law shall remain on disability inactive status for an indefinite period until further order of this Court, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 21.

The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this transfer of status to be published pursuant to Section 18 of Rule 9.
