#### ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court upon the Petition of Disciplinary Counsel for the temporary suspension of William E. Gibson from the practice of law pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The Petition has been authorized by the Chairman of the Board of Professional Responsibility. The Petition is supported by the Affidavits of Judge Leon C. Burns, attorney John Phillip Parsons and Sandy Garrett, Disciplinary Counsel. Based upon the Petition and supporting Affidavits, the Court finds that William E. Gibson, Respondent, poses a substantial threat of irreparable harm to the public.

# It is therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court:

- 1. That William E. Gibson is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Section 4.3, Rule 9 of the Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court.
- 2. That William E. Gibson shall comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects and particularly as provided in Section 18.
- That William E. Gibson, Respondent, may make application for dissolution or modification of this order as provided in Rule 9.
