KNOX COUNTY LAWYER CENSURED

On July 20, 2012, C. Coulter Gilbert, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, received a Public Censure from the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Tennessee Supreme Court.

Mr. Gilbert's license was suspended for CLE noncompliance, and he practiced law for two months while his license was suspended. After he completed the CLE, his license was reinstated.

By the aforementioned acts, C. Coulter Gilbert, has violated Rule of Professional Conduct 5.5 (Unauthorized Practice of Law) and is hereby Publicly Censured for this violation.

A Public Censure is a rebuke and warning to the attorney, but it does not affect the attorney's ability to practice law.

PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against C. Coulter Gilbert, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on June 22, 2012.
