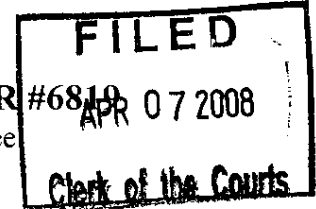

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT


This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed by the Board of Professional Responsibility ("Board"), by and through Disciplinary Counsel, on September 13, 2005; upon Respondent's Answer to Petition filed on October 13, 2005; upon a Supplemental Petition for Discipline filed on April 26, 2006; upon Respondent's Answer to (Supplemental) Petition filed on May 26, 2006; upon a Conditional Guilty Plea filed by Respondent on August 9, 2007, which has been approved by a Hearing Panel and by the Board; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court accepts Respondent's Conditional Guilty Plea and concludes that Respondent should receive a public censure.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** that:

1. Respondent, Mitchell Stanley Givens, be and is hereby publicly censured.
2. Pursuant to Rule 9, Section 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent shall pay the Board's costs in this matter in the sum of \$640.25, and in addition shall pay the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue, if necessary.
3. The Board is directed to cause notice of this Public Censure to be published as required by Rule 9, §18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
