PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against Luvell Leigh Glanton, #014172, an attorney licensed in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on March 14, 2025.

Mr. Glanton instructed his paralegal to appear in Mr. Glanton's stead at a Case Management Conference on February 1, 2023. Paralegals are not permitted to appear alone in these conferences. Mr. Glanton did not attend the Case Management Conference. The paralegal did not disclose that he was not an attorney and was perceived by the Special Master and opposing counsel to be an attorney. Mr. Glanton failed to supervise his paralegal and allowed the paralegal to hold himself out in an attorney's capacity. This action was prejudicial to the administration of justice and required that the Case Management Order be later vacated.

By these acts, Mr. Glanton has violated Rules of Professional Conduct 5.3 (*responsibilities regarding nonlawyer assistance*) and 8.4(d) (*prejudice to the administration of justice*) and is hereby Publicly Censured for these violations.
