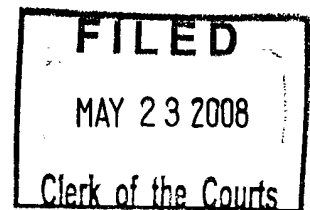

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed against Respondent, Jacques B. Glassman, by the Board of Professional Responsibility ("the Board") on June 23, 2005; upon a Supplemental Petition for Discipline filed on September 18, 2006; upon a Second Supplemental Petition for Discipline filed on January 26, 2007; upon a Third Supplemental Petition for Discipline filed on October 30, 2007; upon a hearing before a Hearing Panel on December 4, 2007; upon the Judgment of the Hearing Panel filed on January 3, 2008; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court approves the Judgment of the Hearing Panel and incorporates the recommendations set forth therein as the Court's Order.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Respondent is hereby suspended from the practice of law for one year pursuant to Rule 9, § 4.2 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.

2. If Respondent is reinstated to the practice of law, Respondent shall be on probation for two years after reinstatement during which time:


(a) Respondent shall not violate the Tennessee Rules of Professional Conduct; and

(b) Respondent shall be monitored by a practice monitor acceptable to Respondent and Disciplinary Counsel who shall (i) communicate with Respondent at least once each week; (ii) meet with Respondent at least once each month; and (iii) file monthly reports to the Board regarding Respondent's practice and Respondent's compliance with the Tennessee Rules of Professional Conduct.

3. Pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent shall pay to the Board the expenses and costs in this matter in the amount of \$2,197.91, and in addition shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution shall issue, if necessary.

4. The Board shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Rule 9, § 18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
