ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Reinstatement filed on June 9, 2010, by Petitioner David Alan Gold; upon the Board's Answer to the Petition filed by Disciplinary Counsel on June 14, 2010; upon the Judgment entered by a Hearing Panel on November 15, 2010; upon the approval of the Board given December 10, 2010; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court approves the recommendation of the Hearing Panel.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court that:

- 1. The Petitioner, David Alan Gold, is hereby reinstated to the practice of law in the State of Tennessee subject to the following conditions:
 - a. For three (3) years following reinstatement, Respondent provide twelve (12) hours community service, outreach or education that furthers the integrity of the legal profession and the importance of a lawyer's personal accountability.
 - b. For a period of one (1) year following reinstatement, Respondent submit to a monthly monitoring by an experienced practitioner.
- 2. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 24.3, the Respondent shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$458.70 and in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.

- The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this discipline to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18.10.
- Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18.5, this Order shall be effective ten (10) days after the date of entry.
