PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against Mark Steven Graham, BPR No. 011505, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on June 13, 2025.

Mr. Graham wrote a check from his trust account to pay an office expense. This check was returned by the bank. Five months later, three automated withdrawals were attempted from the trust account, one of which was paid. Mr. Graham's law license is suspended, and he failed to deactivate his office website for at least 20 months. His social media has incorrectly indicated for at least 34 months that his law license is active.

By the aforementioned acts, Mark Steven Graham has violated Rules of Professional Conduct 1.15 (safekeeping funds), 7.1 (communications concerning a lawyer's services), 3.4 (fairness to opposing party), and 8.4(g) (failure to comply with a court order) and is hereby Publicly Censured for these violations.
