PUBLIC CENSURE



The above complaint was filed against Mark Steven Graham, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered this matter at its meeting on December 10, 2021.

Mr. Graham filed a trademark application when he was suspended from the practice of law in Tennessee, and not licensed to practice law in any other state. His application was on behalf of a client, and it identified Mr. Graham as attorney of record.

By these acts, Mark Steven Graham has violated Rules of Professional Conduct 5.5 (unauthorized practice of law) and 8.4(g) (knowingly fail to comply with a court order) and is hereby publicly censured for these violations.
