By Order of the Tennessee Supreme Court entered July 13, 2022, Stephanie Derrick Gray was reinstated to the active practice of law.

On June 2, 2014, Ms. Gray was placed on disability inactive status by the Supreme Court of Tennessee. ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

This matter is before the Court pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 27.7, upon a Petition for Reinstatement to Active Status Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.7, filed on June 1, 2022, by Petitioner, Stephanie Derrick Gray. Ms. Gray's law license was transferred to disability inactive status by Order of this Court entered June 1, 2014. The Response of the Board of Professional Responsibility to the Petition for Reinstatement to Active Status Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.7 was filed, noting no objection to the Petition for Reinstatement.

From all of which, the Court grants the Petition for Reinstatement.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

1. The Petitioner, Stephanie Derrick Gray, is hereby reinstated to the practice of law in the State of Tennessee pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.7(b).
2. Ms. Gray shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.
3. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11
