## ORDER

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition Requesting Dissolution of Temporary Suspension filed by Respondent, William Lee Gribble, II, on August 29, 2007, and upon the recommendations of a Hearing Panel of the Board of Professional Responsibility ("the Board") filed on October 12, 2007.

From all of which the Court grants Respondent's petition and adopts the recommendations of the Hearing Panel.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED**, **ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court:

- (1) That Respondent's temporary suspension is hereby dissolved and Respondent is permitted to resume the practice of law subject to the following conditions:
  - (i) That Respondent remain in compliance with his Tennessee Lawyer's Assistance Program ("TLAP") contract entered into on August 28, 2007, and that he be monitored by a TLAP monitor during the term of the contract; and
  - (ii) That Respondent obtain three ethics hours of continuing legal education in 2007, and six ethics hours of continuing legal education in 2008, three of which must be obtained on or before June 30, 2008.
- (2) That pursuant to Rule 9, § \$25.1 and 25.3, all documents relating to Respondent's Petition Requesting Dissolution of Temporary Suspension, including the Recommendations of the Hearing Panel, shall be filed under seal.

(3) That pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent shall pay the costs of this proceeding in the sum of \$ 248.00.
