ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of William Lee Gribble, II, from the practice of law, pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the Affidavits of the Honorable William R. Brewer, Jr., the Honorable Jon Kerry Blackwood, the Honorable W. Dale Young, the Honorable Michael A. Gallegos, the Honorable William Terry Denton, and the Honorable David R. Duggan.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Affidavits of the Honorable William R. Brewer, Jr., the Honorable Jon Kerry Blackwood, the Honorable W. Dale Young, the Honorable Michael A. Gallegos, the Honorable William Terry Denton, and the Honorable David R. Duggan, the Court finds that William Lee Gribble, II, poses a threat of substantial harm to the public.


It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. William Lee Gribble, II, is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Section 4.3, Rule 9, of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Tennessee.
2. William Lee Gribble, II, shall comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects, and particularly as provided in Section 18.
3. William Lee Gribble, II, may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Supreme Court Rule 9.


4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of William Lee Gribble, II, to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9.
