**NASHVILLE LAWYER TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED**

On November 17, 2010, the Supreme Court of Tennessee issued an Order summarily and temporarily suspending Kymberly Haas from the practice of law upon finding that Ms. Haas has failed to respond to the Board regarding a complaint of misconduct. Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9 provides for the immediate summary suspension of an attorney's license to practice law in cases of an attorney's failure to respond to the Board regarding a complaint of misconduct.

Effective November 17, 2010, Ms. Haas is precluded from accepting any new clients and she must cease representing existing clients by December 17, 2010. After December 17, 2010, Ms. Haas shall not use any indicia of lawyer, legal assistant, or law clerk nor maintain a presence where the practice of law is conducted.

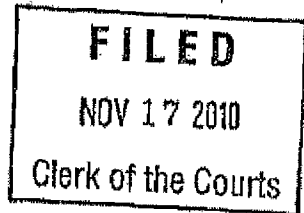
Ms. Haas must notify all clients being represented in pending matters, as well as co-counsel and opposing counsel of the Supreme Court's Order suspending her law license. Section 18 of Supreme Court Rule 9 requires Ms. Haas to deliver to all clients any papers or property to which they are entitled.

This suspension remains in effect until dissolution or modification by the Supreme Court. Ms. Haas may for good cause request dissolution or modification of the suspension by petition to the Supreme Court.

**ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION**

This matter is before the Court on a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Kymberly Lynn Anne Haas from the practice of law, pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the affidavit of James A. Vick, Disciplinary Counsel.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Affidavit, the Court finds that Kymberly Lynn Anne Haas, Respondent, has failed to respond to the Board of Professional Responsibility regarding a complaint of misconduct, File No. 33388-5-JV.

It is therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Kymberly Lynn Anne Haas is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9.
2. Kymberly Lynn Anne Haas must comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects, and particularly as provided in Section 18.
3. Kymberly Lynn Anne Haas may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Supreme Court Rule 9.

4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Kymberly Lynn Anne Haas to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9.
