NASHVILLE LAWYER SUSPENDED

On January 30, 2012, the Tennessee Supreme Court suspended the law license of Kymberly Lynn Anne Haas, a Nashville attorney, for a period of one year.

On May 4, 2011, the Board of Professional Responsibility filed a Petition for Discipline against Ms. Haas, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9. A Hearing Panel found Ms. Haas represented a client in General Sessions Court and signed and made bond for that client in violation of a state statute prohibiting an attorney from such conduct. Ms. Haas did not respond to the Board of Professional Responsibility's Petition.

Ms. Haas' actions violated the following Rules of Professional Conduct: 8.1 (Disciplinary Matters) and 8.4 (Misconduct).

Ms. Haas was further ordered to pay the expenses and costs of the disciplinary proceedings against her, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 24.3, and fully comply in all respects with the requirements and obligations of suspended attorneys as set forth in Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18.

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed May 4, 2011, by the Board of Professional Responsibility ("Board") against Kymberly Lynn Anne Haas in Docket No. 2011-2045-5-RS; upon the Board's Motion for Default Judgment filed May 31, 2011; upon the Judgment of the Hearing Panel entered on September 14, 2011; upon service of the Judgment on Ms. Haas sent by the Board on November 21, 2011; upon the Board's consideration and approval on December 9, 2011; upon expiration of the time to appeal with no appeal taken; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court approves the Judgment of the Hearing Panel and adopts the Judgment of the Hearing Panel as the Court's Order.

By Order entered November 17, 2010, in Case No. M2010-02351-SC-BPR-BP, Ms. Haas was temporarily suspended from the practice of law pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §4.3. Further, Ms. Haas was suspended for CLB noncompliance on September 7, 2010. To date, Ms. Haas has not requested nor been granted reinstatement.


It is, therefore, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that:

1. Kymberly Lynn Anne Haas is hereby suspended from the practice of law for a period of one year pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 4.2.
2. The suspension shall become effective ten (10) days after the filing of this Order.
3. Ms. Haas shall comply in all aspects with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 18 and 19 regarding the obligations and responsibilities of suspended attorneys and the procedure for reinstatement.
4. Upon entry of this Order, the Order of Temporary Suspension entered November 17, 2010 is hereby dissolved.

5. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 24.3, Ms. Haas shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$1,017.00 and, in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.

6. The Board shall cause notice of this discipline to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 18.10.
