## ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed against Myra Ann Hamilton on October 23, 2024; upon a Conditional Guilty Plea filed by Ms. Hamilton on November 4, 2024; upon the Hearing Panel's Order Recommending Approval of Conditional Guilty Plea entered November 15, 2024; upon consideration and approval by the Board of Professional Responsibility on December 13, 2024; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court approves the Order of the Hearing Panel and adopts the Order Recommending Approval of Conditional Guilty Plea as the Court's Order.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

- (1) Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.4 (2014), Myra Ann Hamilton is hereby publicly censured.
- (2) Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 31.3(d), Ms. Hamilton shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs incurred to date by the Board in this matter in the amount of \$956.00. Ms. Hamilton shall be assessed \$100.00 for the cost of filing this matter and pay this filing fee to the Board and shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the court costs incurred herein. All costs, fees and expenses awarded or assessed herein shall be paid within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order for which execution, if necessary, may issue.
- (3) The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this discipline to be published.
- (4) Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.1, this Order shall be effective upon entry.
