**DAVIDSON COUNTY LAWYER REINSTATED**

On June 15, 2015, the Supreme Court of Tennessee reinstated William Caldwell Hancock to the practice of law. Mr. Hancock was suspended from the practice of law by Order of the Court on September 30, 2014, for a period of thirty (30) days.

On May 6, 2015, Mr. Hancock filed a Petition for Reinstatement to the practice of law. Pursuant to Tennessee Supreme Court, Rule 9, Section 30.4(c), the Board verified that the conditions required for reinstatement were satisfied and filed a Notice of Submission with the Supreme Court indicating Mr. Hancock was eligible for reinstatement to the practice of law. The Order of Reinstatement entered June 15, 2015, was effective upon filing.

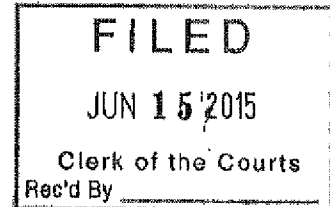

**ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT**

This matter is before the Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c), upon a Petition for Reinstatement filed on May 6, 2015, by the Petitioner, William Caldwell Hancock. Mr. Hancock was suspended from the practice of law by Order of this Court on September 3, 2014, for a period of thirty (30) days. A Notice of Submission was filed by the Chief Disciplinary Counsel indicating that the petition is satisfactory to the Board and that Mr. Hancock has satisfied all conditions set forth in the Order imposing discipline and that he is eligible for reinstatement.

From all of which the Court grants the Petition for Reinstatement.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT:

1. The Petitioner, William Caldwell Hancock, is hereby reinstated to the practice of law in the State of Tennessee pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c).
2. Mr. Hancock shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.
3. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
