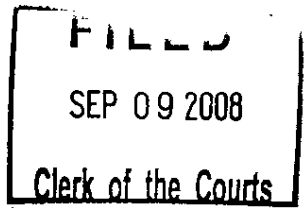

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

On January 20, 2007, the Board of Professional Responsibility ("Board"), by and through Disciplinary Counsel, filed a Petition for Discipline against Respondent, Linda Diane Schlanger Harris, based upon Respondent's pleading guilty to conspiracy to defraud mortgage loan companies and financial institutions.

Pursuant to Section 16.1 of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Respondent has submitted a Conditional Guilty Plea in which she agrees to be suspended from the practice of law for five (5) years, retroactive to June 29, 2006, the date of Respondent's sentencing hearing. The Conditional Guilty Plea has been approved by a Hearing Panel and by the Board.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** that:

1. Respondent is suspended from the practice of law for five (5) years, retroactive to June 29, 2006.
2. Pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent shall pay to the Board the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$446.46, and in addition shall pay the clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue, if necessary.
3. The Board shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Rule 9, § 18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
