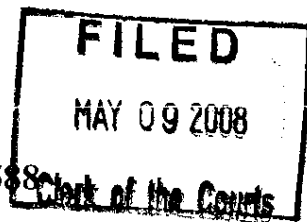

**ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT**

The Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, filed a Petition for Discipline against the Respondent, William Anthony Helm.


Pursuant to Section 8 of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, the Findings and Judgment of the Hearing Panel was entered on October 29, 2007, finding that the Respondent should be disbarred.

A copy of the Findings and Judgment of the Hearing Panel is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Respondent, William Anthony Helm, is disbarred from the practice of law.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Respondent, William Anthony Helm, shall pay the costs in this matter of \$521.78 and, in addition, shall pay the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution shall issue, if necessary.
