LOUDON COUNTY LAWYER CENSURED

On April 16, 2018, Arthur Wayne Henry, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, received a Public Censure from the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Tennessee Supreme Court.

On September 21, 2017, Mr. Henry was retained to represent a client in a domestic case in which the client desired to relocate with her child to another state. On December 4, 2017, the client discovered that Mr. Henry had taken no action to file a petition to relocate or to answer the opposing party's petition. Mr. Henry did refund the client's fees after she confronted him about the inactivity on the case.

By these acts, Arthur Wayne Henry, has violated Rule of Professional Conduct 1.3 (diligence), 1.4 (communication), and 3.2 (expediting litigation) and is hereby Publicly Censured for this violation.

A Public Censure is a rebuke and warning to the attorney, but it does not affect the attorney's ability to practice law.

PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against Arthur Wayne Henry, #9484, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on March 9, 2018.

Mr. Henry was hired to represent his client in a domestic case and failed to take any action on the case to protect his client's interests for over two months. Mr. Henry has issued his client a complete refund. However, Mr. Henry's conduct in this case is consistent with the pattern of neglecting client matters that has resulted in prior public discipline.

By the aforementioned acts, Arthur Wayne Henry has violated Rule of Professional Conduct 1.3 (diligence), 1.4 (communication), and 3.2 (expediting litigation) and is hereby Publicly Censured for these violations.
