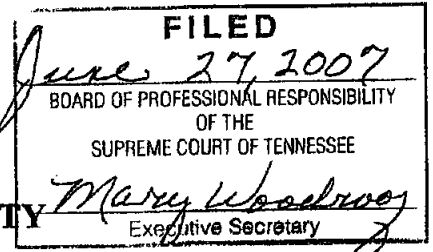

PUBLIC CENSURE

The above matter was filed against Janice G. Hicks who practices law in Anderson County, Tennessee. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered this matter and determined that an informal public censure was appropriate.

In a matter before Anderson County Criminal Court, Ms. Hicks was not reasonably diligent in paying attention to representing the State on motion day causing a brief disruption in court proceedings for which Ms. Hicks apologized to the trial judge.

Ms. Hicks has thereby violated Rule 1.3 of the Tennessee Rules of Professional Conduct.
