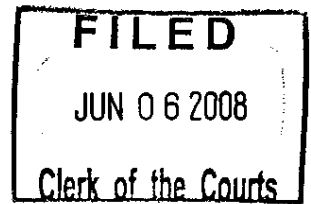

**ORDER ON REINSTATEMENT**

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Reinstatement filed by Petitioner, Warner R. Hodges, III, on November 5, 2007; upon a hearing before a Hearing Panel of the Board of Professional Responsibility ("the Board") on March 17, 2008; upon the Judgment of the Hearing Panel filed on April 2, 2008; and upon the entire record in this cause.


From all of which the Court finds, pursuant to Rule 9, § 19.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, that Petitioner has demonstrated by clear and convincing evidence that he has the moral qualifications, competency and learning in law required for admission to practice law in this state and that his resumption of the practice of law will not be detrimental to the integrity or standing of the bar or the administration of justice, or subversive to the public interest.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Respondent is reinstated to the practice of law, conditioned upon Respondent:
  - (a) maintaining full and unconditional compliance with the remainder of his monitoring/advocacy agreement with the Tennessee Lawyer Assistance Program which extends through May 17, 2010; and
  - (b) maintaining his involvement with the Georgia Lawyers' Assistance Program.
2. As a further condition of Respondent's reinstatement, Respondent shall, pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, pay to the Board the expenses and costs of this matter, and in addition pay any costs assessed by the Clerk of this Court in this cause, for all of which execution may issue, if necessary.

3. The Board shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Rule 9, § 18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
