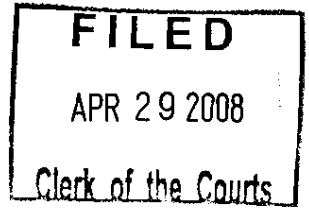


**ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT**

In this cause, the Petitioner, Newton S. Holiday, was temporarily suspended by Order of the Supreme Court of Tennessee entered on March 5, 2008 for failure to respond to the Board of Professional Responsibility concerning a complaint of misconduct. On March 19, 2008, the Petitioner filed a Petition to Request Dissolution of Temporary Order of Suspension. On April 2, 2008, a Hearing Panel heard the Petitioner's Petition to Request Dissolution of Temporary Order of Suspension. On April 11, 2008, this Hearing Panel filed its Report and Recommendation with the Board of Professional Responsibility which concluded that the Petitioner's Petition to Request Dissolution of Temporary Order of Suspension for Reinstatement should be granted.

It is therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. The Report and Recommendation of the Hearing Panel is approved and entered for enforcement by this Court.
2. The Order of Temporary Suspension entered on March 5, 2008 is hereby dissolved.
3. The Petitioner shall detail by affidavit to be filed with the Board of Professional Responsibility his efforts to comply with Section 18 of Rule 9 as required by the Order of Temporary Suspension.
