PUBLIC CENSURE



The above complaint was filed against Jason Daniel Holleman, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered this matter at its meeting on March 13, 2020.

Mr. Holleman placed a concealed tracking device on the motor vehicle of an ex-girlfriend and traced her whereabouts without her consent for a period of approximately six months. Mr. Holleman's actions were prohibited by law.

By the aforementioned acts, Jason Daniel Holleman has violated Rule of Professional Conduct 8.4(a), (b), and (c) (misconduct), and is hereby Publicly Censured for these violations.
