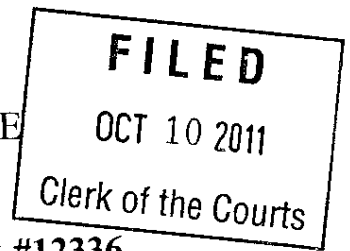

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed May 3, 2011 by the Board of Professional Responsibility ("Board") against Donald Sutherland Holm, III, ("Respondent"); upon Respondent's Answer to the Petition for Discipline filed on June 2, 2011; upon entry of a Conditional Guilty Plea by Respondent on August 26, 2011; upon an Order Recommending Approval of Conditional Guilty Plea entered by the Hearing Panel on September 12, 2011; upon consideration and approval of the Board on September 23, 2011; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court approves the recommendation of the Hearing Panel and accepts the Conditional Guilty Plea.


It is therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Respondent, Donald Sutherland Holm, III, be and is hereby suspended for six (6) months pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 4.2.
2. The suspension shall become effective within ten (10) days of the filing of this Order.
3. Respondent shall comply in all aspects with Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18 regarding the obligations and responsibilities of suspended attorneys.
4. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 24.3, the Respondent shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$288.33 and, in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of

this Court the costs incurred herein, within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.

5. The Board shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18.10.
