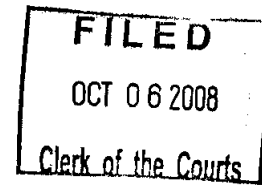

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed by the Board of Professional Responsibility ("the Board") against Respondent, M. Josiah Hoover, on June 14, 2007; upon a Supplemental Petition for Discipline filed by the Board against Respondent on July 6, 2007; upon a Conditional Guilty Plea submitted by Respondent on March 13, 2008, pursuant to Rule 9, Section 16.1 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, which plea has been approved by a Hearing Panel and by the Board; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court approves the terms of the Conditional Guilty Plea and adopts and incorporates the terms contained therein as the Court's Order.

It is therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Pursuant to Rule 9, Section 4.2 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent is suspended from the practice of law for a period of thirty (30) days, the imposition of which is suspended in conjunction with a thirty (30) day period of probation.
2. Respondent shall comply in all aspects with Rule 9, Section 18 of the Rules of the Supreme Court regarding the obligations and responsibilities of suspended attorneys.
3. Pursuant to Rule 9, Section 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent shall pay to the Board the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$466.24, and, in addition, shall pay the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue, if necessary.
4. The Board shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Rule 9, Section 18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
