PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against Angela Joy Hopson, #22500, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on March 11, 2016.

In September of 2015, Ms. Hopson's license was suspended for failure to pay the Professional Privilege Tax. On October 30, 2015, Ms. Hopson appeared in court representing a defendant in criminal case. Ms. Hopson continued practicing law for two more weeks, when a colleague drew her attention again to the administrative suspension. Ms. Hopson's license was returned to active status on November 17, 2015.

By the aforementioned acts, Angela Joy Hopson has violated Rule of Professional Conduct 5.5 (unauthorized practice of law) and is hereby Publicly Censured for this violation.
