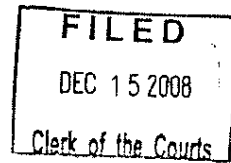

ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Respondent, Sean K. Hornbeck, from the practice of law pursuant to Rule 9, Section 4.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by a Verified Complaint in Intervention and certified Orders from the Chancery Court of Davidson County.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting documentation, the Court finds that Sean K. Hornbeck poses a threat of substantial harm to the public.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Respondent is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Rule 9, Section 4.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
2. Respondent shall comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects, and particularly as provided in Section 18.
3. Respondent may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Supreme Court Rule 9.
4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Rule 9, Section 18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
