ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Reginald Horton, from the practice of law, pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the Affidavits of Sandy Garrett, Deputy Chief Disciplinary Counsel – Litigation and Drug Task Force Sergeant Richard Hamilton.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Affidavits, the Court finds that Reginald Horton, Respondent, poses a threat of substantial harm to the public.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court:

- 1. That Reginald Horton is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9.
- 2. That Reginald Horton comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects, and particularly as provided in Section 18.
- 3. That Reginald Horton may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Supreme Court Rule 9.
- 4. That the Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Reginald Horton to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9.
