**NASHVILLE ATTORNEY SUSPENDED**

On September 3, 2010, the Tennessee Supreme Court suspended the law license of Reginald Lamont Horton pursuant to Section 14 of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9. The Court suspended Mr. Horton's law license based upon Mr. Horton's plea of guilty to serious crimes, i.e., delivery of .5 gr. cocaine; possession of .5 gr. cocaine with intent to deliver; attempted theft of property of over \$1,000; facilitation of sale of 300 gr. cocaine; and possession of 10 lbs. marijuana with intent to deliver.

The Supreme Court further ordered the Board of Professional Responsibility to institute a formal proceeding to determine the extent of final discipline to be imposed as a result of the conviction. Mr. Horton was ordered to fully comply with the provisions of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 18. Since April 17, 2009, Mr. Horton has been temporarily suspended by the Tennessee Supreme Court for posing a threat of substantial harm to the public by offering to provide legal services in exchange for stolen property.

This suspension shall remain in effect until it is dissolved or amended by order of the Supreme Court of Tennessee.

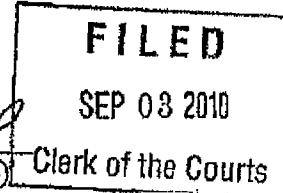

**ORDER OF SUSPENSION**

This matter is before the Court pursuant to Section 14 of Rule 9, Rules of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, upon a certificate filed by Disciplinary Counsel for the Board of Professional Responsibility consisting of a certified copy of the Judgments In a Criminal Case, State of Tennessee v. Reginald Lamont Horton, (attached as Exhibit A) filed in the Criminal Court for Davidson County on August 18, 2010, demonstrating that Reginald Lamont Horton, a Tennessee attorney, has pled guilty to serious crimes, i.e., delivery of 0.5 gr. cocaine; possession 0.5 gr. cocaine with intent to deliver; attempted theft of property of over \$1,000; facilitation of sale of 0/300 gr. cocaine; possession of 0/10 lbs. marijuana with intent to deliver.

It is therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Reginald Lamont Horton is suspended from the practice of law on this date pending further orders of this Court, pursuant to Section 14 of Rule 9 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Tennessee;
2. This matter shall be referred to the Board of Professional Responsibility for the institution of a formal proceeding in which the sole issue to be determined shall be the extent of the final discipline to be imposed as a result of the conviction by the Guilty Plea;
3. Reginald Lamont Horton shall fully comply with the provisions of Section 18 of Rule 9, Rules of the Supreme Court, concerning disbarred or suspended attorneys; and

4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9.
