## ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Martin Lynn Howie, from the practice of law, pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the Affidavit of Rachel Waterhouse, Deputy Chief Disciplinary Counsel in Investigations.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Affidavit, the Court finds that Martin Lynn Howie, Respondent, poses a threat of substantial harm to the public.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court:

- That Martin Lynn Howie is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as 1. provided in Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9.
- That Martin Lynn Howie comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects, and particularly as provided in Section 18.
- That Martin Lynn Howie may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Supreme Court Rule 9.
- That the Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Martin Lynn Howie to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9.
