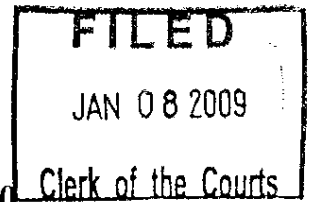

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed by Disciplinary Counsel against Respondent, James Albert Hurst, Jr., on November 8, 2007; upon the entering of a Conditional Guilty Plea by the Respondent on October 24, 2008; upon the Order Recommending Approval of Conditional Guilty Plea by a Hearing Panel on November 6, 2008; upon the submission to the Court of a Protocol Memorandum on January 2, 2009; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which the Court approves the recommendation of the Hearing Panel and accepts the Conditional Guilty Plea.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court,

1. That Respondent is hereby publicly censured pursuant to Rule 9, §4.4 of the Rules of the Supreme Court; and
2. That pursuant to Rule 9, §24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, Respondent shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$157.00, assessed by the Clerk of this Court in this cause, for all of which execution shall issue if necessary; and
3. That the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court cause notice of this public censure to be published as required by Rule 9, §18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Tennessee.
