KNOX COUNTY LAWYER REINSTATED

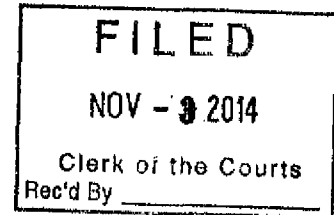
On November 3, 2014, the Supreme Court of Tennessee reinstated the law license of Roger David Hyman. Mr. Hyman's law license had been suspended by the Supreme Court of Tennessee on March 31, 2014, for a period of six (6) months. Mr. Hyman petitioned for reinstatement on September 30, 2014. Based upon the Board's notification that Mr. Hyman had satisfied all conditions set forth in the Order imposing discipline and that the petition was satisfactory to the Board, the Court reinstated Mr. Hyman's license to practice law. Mr. Hyman was ordered to pay costs of the reinstatement.

ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

This matter is before the Court, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 30.4(c), upon a Petition for Reinstatement filed on September 30, 2014, by the Petitioner, Roger David Hyman. Mr. Hyman was suspended from the practice of law by Order of this Court on March 31, 2014, for a period of six (6) months. A Notice of Submission was filed by the Chief Disciplinary Counsel indicating that the petition is satisfactory to the Board and that Mr. Hyman has satisfied all conditions set forth in the Order imposing discipline and that he is eligible for reinstatement.

From all of which the Court grants the Petition for Reinstatement.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT:

1. The Petitioner, Roger David Hyman, is hereby reinstated to the practice of law in the State of Tennessee pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §30.4(c).
2. Mr. Hyman shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for all of which execution may issue if necessary.
3. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this reinstatement to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
