ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed against John Benneth Iwu ("Mr. Iwu") on July 3, 2024; upon Amended Conditional Guilty Plea entered by Mr. Iwu on September 24, 2024; upon entry of the Amended Order Recommending Approval of Conditional Guilty Plea entered by the Hearing Panel on September 24, 2024; upon consideration and approval by the Board on September 26, 2024; and upon the entire record in this issue.

From all of which, the Court approves the Order of the Hearing Panel and adopts the Amended Order Recommending Approval of Conditional Guilty Plea as the Court's Order.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

- (1) Pursuant to Tenn, Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.4 (2014), John Benneth Iwu is hereby publicly censured.
- (2) Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §31.3(d), Mr. Iwu shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs incurred to date by the Board in this matter in the amount of \$538.00. Mr. Iwu shall be assessed \$100.00 for the cost of filing this matter, pay this filing fee to the Board, and shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the court costs incurred herein. All costs, fees, and expenses awarded or assessed herein shall be paid within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order for which execution, if necessary, may issue.

- (3) The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this discipline to be published.
- (4) Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, §28.1, this Order shall be effective upon entry.
