SULLIVAN COUNTY LAWYER TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED

On June 17, 2016, the Supreme Court of Tennessee temporarily suspended Wendal Douglas Jackson from the practice of law upon finding that Mr. Jackson poses a substantial threat of harm to the public, pursuant to Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 12.3.

Mr. Jackson is immediately precluded from accepting any new cases and from representing existing clients upon entry of the Order dated June 17, 2016. After June 17, 2016, Mr. Jackson shall not use any indicia of lawyer, legal assistant, or law clerk nor maintain a presence where the practice of law is conducted.

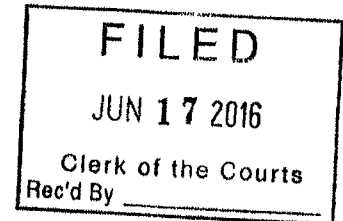
Mr. Jackson must notify all clients being represented in pending matters, as well as co-counsel and opposing counsel of the Supreme Court's Order suspending his law license. Mr. Jackson is required to deliver to all clients any papers or property to which they are entitled.

This suspension remains in effect until dissolution or modification by the Supreme Court. Mr. Jackson may for good cause request dissolution or modification of the suspension by petition to the Supreme Court.

ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court on a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Wendal Douglas Jackson from the practice of law, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the affidavits of William C. Moody, Disciplinary Counsel; R. Luke Widener, Esq.; and Robyn Carey; and exhibits.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting affidavits, the Court finds that Wendal Douglas Jackson, Respondent, poses a threat of substantial harm to the public.

IT IS THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

1. Wendal Douglas Jackson is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3.
2. Mr. Jackson is precluded from continuing to represent existing clients beyond the effective date of this order.
3. Wendal Douglas Jackson shall comply with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 in all respects and particularly as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, regarding the responsibilities of suspended attorneys.
4. Wendal Douglas Jackson may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3.

5. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Wendal Douglas Jackson to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
