TENNESSEE LAWYER SUSPENDED

By Order of Reciprocal Discipline entered by the Supreme Court of Tennessee on September 2, 2026, William Henry Jackson received a six (6) month and one (1) day suspension retroactive to April 17, 2026. Mr. Jackson was suspended by the Supreme Judicial Court for the State of Nevada for six (6) months and one (1) day by Order Approving Conditional Admission Agreement entered April 17, 2026, in violation of Nevada Rules of Professional Conduct 5.4(a) (professional independence of a lawyer and 7.2(a) (advertising).

On July 15, 2026, the Supreme Court entered a Notice of Reciprocal Discipline directing Mr. Jackson to inform the Court, within thirty (30) days of receipt of the Notice, why the discipline imposed by the Supreme Judicial Court for the State of Nevada should not be imposed in Tennessee. Mr. Jackson did not provide a response to the Supreme Court of Tennessee within the time prescribed.

Mr. Jackson must comply with the requirements of Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 9, Sections 28 and 30.4, regarding the obligations and responsibilities of suspended attorneys and the procedure for reinstatement.
