ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court on a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Stephanie Branam Johnson from the practice of law, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the Affidavit of Diane M. Nisbet, Disciplinary Counsel.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Affidavit, the Court finds that Stephanie Branam Johnson, Respondent, failed to respond to the Board of Professional Responsibility concerning complaints of misconduct in File Nos. 68433-4-DN and 68619-4-DN.

- 1. Stephanie Branam Johnson is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3.
- 2. Stephanie Branam Johnson shall comply with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 in all respects and particularly as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28, regarding the responsibilities of suspended attorneys.
- 3. Stephanie Branam Johnson may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3.
- 4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Stephanie Branam Johnson to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.
