failed to adequately communicate with his client during the representation.

By the aforementioned acts, Samuel Jones, has violated Rule of Professional Conduct 1.3

(diligence), 1.4 (communication), 3.2 (expediting litigation), and 8.4(a) and (d) (misconduct) and is

hereby Publicly Censured for this violation.
