PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against David Bennett LaRoche, #025516, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on March 13, 2026.

On July 30, 2025, Mr. LaRoche was issued a Private Reprimand under TBPR Case No. 100906-2025-4-MH-INV for violations of the Rules of Professional Conduct 1.1 (competence); 1.3 (diligence); 1.4 (communication); and 1.16 (declining or terminating representation). Additionally, as a condition of the Private Reprimand, Mr. LaRoche was ordered to refund \$500 to the Complainant within 60 days of issuance of the Private Reprimand. Mr. LaRoche failed to refund the money and failed to respond to a lawful demand for information from Disciplinary Counsel concerning this matter.


By these acts, Mr. LaRoche has violated Rules of Professional Conduct 3.1 (meritorious claims and contentions), 8.1 (bar admission and disciplinary matters), and 8.4 (misconduct) and is

hereby Publicly Censured for these violations.
