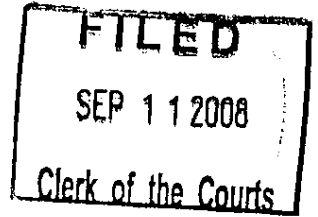

ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Dissolution of Temporary Suspension filed by Michael Latimore ("Respondent") on June 23, 2008; upon the Judgment of the Hearing Panel filed on August 15, 2008; and upon the entire record of this cause.

From all of which the Court grants the Respondent's Petition and adopts the judgment and recommendation of the Hearing Panel.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. That Respondent's temporary suspension is hereby dissolved and Respondent is permitted to resume the practice of law based upon his agreement to contact the Tennessee Lawyer's Assistance Program ("TLAP") and to comply with TLAP's recommendations.

2. Pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, the Respondent shall pay to the Board the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$ 406.67, and in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue if necessary. Payment of the costs assessed by the Board pursuant to Rule 9, §24.3 is required as a condition precedent to reinstatement of the Respondent.
