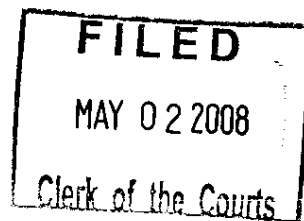

ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION


This matter is before the Court upon a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Michael Edward Latimore from the practice of law, pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the affidavit of Daryl J. Brand, Disciplinary Counsel.

Based upon the Petition and supporting documentation, this Court finds that Respondent has failed to respond to the Board regarding a disciplinary complaint of ethical misconduct.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Michael Edward Latimore is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9.
2. Respondent shall comply with Rule 9, Section 18 of the Rules of the Supreme Court regarding the obligations and responsibilities of suspended attorneys.
3. Michael Edward Latimore may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Supreme Court Rule 9.
4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension to be published as required by Rule 9, § 18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
