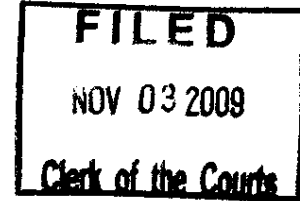

ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Dissolution of Temporary Suspension filed by Michael Edward Latimore ("Petitioner") on September 21, 2009; upon the Judgment of the Hearing Panel filed on October 23, 2009; and upon the entire record of this cause.

From all of which the Court grants the Petition and adopts the judgment and recommendation of the Hearing Panel to reinstate Petitioner to the practice of law.

It is, therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Petitioner's temporary suspension is hereby dissolved and Petitioner is permitted to resume the practice of law. Further, Petitioner is ordered to enroll in the Tennessee Lawyers Assistance Program ("TLAP") within thirty (30) days of this Order. Petitioner shall provide a statement to the Board of Professional Responsibility within thirty (30) days confirming that an assessment has been scheduled with TLAP.

2. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 24.3, the Petitioner shall pay to the Board the expenses and costs of this matter in the amount of \$ 468.33, and in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution may issue if necessary. Payment of the costs assessed by the Board pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, Section 24.3 is required as a condition precedent to reinstatement of the Respondent.
