PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against Lindsey Leigh Lawrence, #032697, an attorney

licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Tenn. Sup.

Ct. R. 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on June

9, 2023.

In the representation of a client in connection with a probate matter, Ms. Lawrence failed

to pursue the client's legal objectives, and did not maintain good communication with her client.

Investigation also revealed that Ms. Lawrence formerly maintained a YouTube channel where she

posted videos of herself smoking marijuana. Ms. Lawrence identifies herself as an attorney in

these videos. By openly engaging in conduct that is criminally actionable in Tennessee, Ms.

Lawrence demonstrated a lack of respect for the law and legal institutions.

By these acts, Ms. Lawrence has violated Rules of Professional Conduct 1.3 (diligence);

1.4 (communication); 8.4(b) (criminal conduct); and 8.4(d) (conduct prejudicial to the

administration of justice) and is hereby Publicly Censured for these violations.
