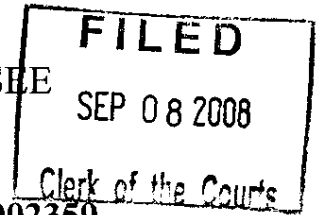

ORDER OF DISBARMENT

This matter is before the Court upon the Affidavit of James David Leckrone ("Respondent") filed in compliance with Rule 9, § 15.1 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, in which Respondent consents to disbarment because he cannot successfully defend himself on certain charges alleged in a Petition for Final Discipline filed against him by the Board of Professional Responsibility ("Board"). Respondent plead guilty in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Tennessee, Nashville Division, to filing a false tax return and concedes that he has violated Rule 8.4(a)(b)(c)(d) of the Tennessee Rules of Professional Conduct.

It is therefore **ORDERED, ADJUDGED** and **DECREED** by the Court that:

1. Respondent is disbarred from the practice of law.
2. Pursuant to Rule 9, § 15.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court, this Order of Disbarment shall be a matter of public record; however, the Affidavit filed by Respondent shall not be publicly disclosed or made available for use in any other proceeding except upon further Order of this Court.
3. Respondent shall comply with the requirements and obligations of disbarred attorneys as set forth in Rule 9, § 18 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
4. The Board shall cause notice of this disbarment to be published as set forth in Rule 9, § 18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
