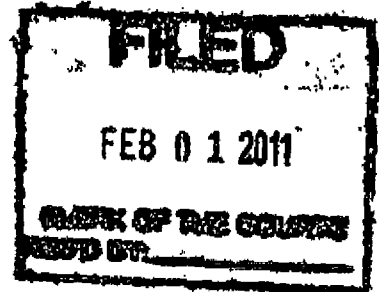

**ORDER**



On January 5, 2011, Peggy Lee filed a "Pauper's Oath in Lieu of Appeal Bond" that did not include a Uniform Civil Affidavit of Indigency as required by Tenn. R. App. P. 18(d). On January 7, 2011, the Court ordered Ms. Lee, within fifteen (15) days of entry of the order, either to file a bond for costs on appeal or to show cause why her appeal should not be dismissed for failure to comply with Tenn. R. App. P. 6. Ms. Lee has neither filed a response to the show cause order nor filed an appeal bond as required by Tenn. R. App. P. 6.

It is, therefore, ordered that this appeal is dismissed for failure to comply with Tenn. R. App. P. 6. The costs shall be taxed to Peggy Lee.
