ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

This matter is before the Court on a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Vanessa Lynn Lemons from the practice of law, pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the affidavit of James A. Vick, Disciplinary Counsel.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Affidavit, the Court finds that Vanessa Lynn Lemons, Respondent, has failed to respond to the Board of Professional Responsibility concerning a request for specific information regarding a complaint of misconduct, File No. 32480c-2-JV.

It is therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court that:

- 1. Vanessa Lynn Lemons is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law as provided in Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9.
- 2. Vanessa Lynn Lemons shall comply with Supreme Court Rule 9 in all respects, and particularly as provided in Section 18.
- 3. Vanessa Lynn Lemons may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Supreme Court Rule 9.

4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Vanessa Lynn Lemons to be published as required by Supreme Court Rule 9.
