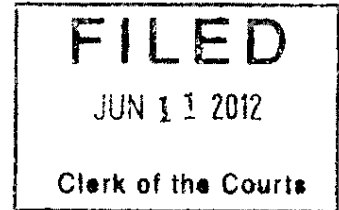

ORDER

This matter is before the Court on a Petition of the Board of Professional Responsibility of the Supreme Court of Tennessee, by and through Disciplinary Counsel, for the temporary suspension of Vanessa Lynn Lemons from the practice of law, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 4.3. The Petition has been authorized by the Chair of the Board of Professional Responsibility and is supported by the affidavit of Elizabeth C. Garber, Disciplinary Counsel.

Based upon the Petition and the supporting Affidavit, the Court finds that Vanessa Lynn Lemons has failed to respond to the Board of Professional Responsibility concerning a complaint of misconduct.

It is therefore, ordered, adjudged, and decreed by the Court that:

1. Vanessa Lynn Lemons is hereby temporarily suspended from the practice of law pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 4.3.
2. Vanessa Lynn Lemons shall comply with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9 in all respects, and particularly as provided in § 18.
3. Vanessa Lynn Lemons may make application for dissolution or modification of this Order as provided in Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 4.3.
4. The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this suspension of Vanessa Lynn Lemons to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 18.10.
