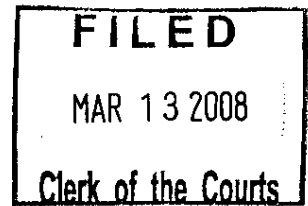

ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed by the Board of Professional Responsibility ("Board") against Quisha A. Light ("Respondent"), on April 5, 2007; upon Respondent's Answer to Petition for Discipline filed on May 7, 2007; upon a Conditional Guilty Plea filed on July 10, 2007; and upon the entire record in this cause.


From all of which the Court approves the discipline set forth in the Conditional Guilty Plea and adopts the terms set forth therein as the Court's Order.

**IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT**  
that:

1. Respondent, Quisha A. Light is suspended from the practice of law for four years effective May 30, 2007.
2. Pursuant to Section 24.3 of Rule 9 of this Court, Respondent shall pay to the Board the costs and expenses of this proceeding in the sum of \$840.63 and, in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution shall issue, if necessary.
3. As conditions of reinstatement, Respondent shall :
  - (a) pay the sum of \$5,952.50 to Attorney Michelle Benjamin as restitution;
  - (b) pay the costs assessed herein pursuant to Rule 9, § 24.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court; and
  - (c) fully comply with the provisions set forth in Rule 9, § Section 18 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.

4. The Board is directed to make notification of this suspension as provided in Rule 9, § 18.10 of the Rules of the Supreme Court.
