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**ORDER OF ENFORCEMENT**

This matter is before the Court upon a Petition for Discipline filed against Marcus Allen Lipham on May 21, 2025; upon a Motion for Default Judgment and That All Allegations and Exhibits Included in Petition for Discipline be Deemed Admitted filed on July 29, 2025; upon an Order of Default Judgment filed on September 9, 2025; upon service of Order of Default Judgment on Mr. Lipham by the Executive Secretary of the Board on September 9, 2025; upon Judgment of the Hearing Panel filed on December 8, 2025; upon service of the Judgment of the Hearing Panel on Mr. Lipham by the Executive Secretary of the Board on December 8, 2025; upon the Board of Professional Responsibility's Application for Assessment of Costs filed on December 19, 2025; upon Findings and Judgment for Assessment of Costs entered on January 7, 2026; upon service of Findings and Judgment for Assessment of Costs on Mr. Lipham by the Executive Secretary of the Board on January 7, 2026; upon the Board's February 19, 2026 vote not to appeal the Hearing Panel's decision; upon expiration of the appeal period with no appeal taken; and upon the entire record in this cause.

From all of which, the Court approves the Judgment of the Hearing Panel and the Findings and Judgment for Assessment of Costs entered by the Hearing Panel and adopts the same as its judgment.

On November 18, 2024, Mr. Lipham was temporarily suspended by this Court pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 12.3 (Case No. M2024-01705-SC-BAR-BP). To date, Mr. Lipham has not requested or been granted reinstatement.

IT IS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED BY THE COURT THAT:

- (1) Mr. Lipham is permanently disbarred from the practice of law pursuant to

Tenn. Sup. Ct., R., § 12.1.

(2) Mr. Lipham shall pay restitution in the total amount of \$26,500.00 to the following individuals, pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R., § 12.7:

- Scott Campbell in the amount of \$3,500.00
- Wolf Schexnider in the amount of \$3,500.00
- Robert C. McLemore in the amount of \$3,000.00
- Dawn Bennett in the amount of \$2,500.00
- Tina Mosier in the amount of \$6,000.00
- Shaun Poole in the amount of \$3,500.00
- Sha Yvonne Savov in the amount of \$4,500.00

(3) In the event restitution is made by the Tennessee Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection (TLFCP), Mr. Lipham shall reimburse TLFCP in the same amount.

(4) Mr. Lipham shall comply in all aspects with Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28 regarding the obligations and responsibilities of disbarred attorneys.

(5) Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 31.3(d), Mr. Lipham shall pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the expenses and costs incurred to date by the Board in this matter in the amount of \$2,216.00, which includes an assessed \$100.00 for the cost of filing this matter and shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the court costs incurred herein. All costs, fees, and expenses awarded or assessed herein shall be paid within ninety (90) days of the entry of this Order, for which execution, if necessary, may issue.

(6) The Order of Temporary Suspension entered November 18, 2024 (Case No. M2024-01705-SC-BAR-BP) is hereby dissolved.

(7) The Board of Professional Responsibility shall cause notice of this discipline to be published as required by Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.11.

(8) Pursuant to Tenn. Sup. Ct. R. 9, § 28.1, this Order shall be effective upon entry.
