ORDER

On March 3, 2011, the Court entered an Order of Temporary Suspension suspending Ivan Omar Lopez pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9 due to Mr. Lopez's substantial non-compliance with his Monitoring Agreement with the Tennessee Lawyers Assistance Program. On March 3, 2011, Mr. Lopez filed an "Answer ... and Petition for Dismissal of Action". On March 4, 2011, the Court entered an Order treating the "Answer . . . and Petition for Dismissal of Action" as a Petition for Dissolution of Temporary Suspension pursuant to Section 4.3 of Supreme Court Rule 9 and ordered the Board to take appropriate steps to provide an immediate hearing pursuant to Section 4.3.

On March 29, 2011, a hearing was conducted before a three-member Hearing Panel of the Board of Professional Responsibility. On March 30, 2011, the Hearing Panel entered its Report and Recommendation, recommending that the temporary suspension imposed by the Order of Temporary Suspension be dissolved. A copy of the Report and Recommendation of the 4.3 Hearing Panel is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that:

- The temporary suspension imposed upon Ivan Omar Lopez by Order of Temporary Suspension filed March 3, 2011, is hereby dissolved and Ivan Omar Lopez is reinstated to the practice of law;
- Mr. Lopez shall reimburse and pay to the Board of Professional Responsibility the costs and expenses of this proceeding in the amount of \$481.66 and, in addition, shall pay to the Clerk of this Court the costs incurred herein, for all of which execution shall issue, if necessary.
