PUBLIC CENSURE

The above complaint was filed against Ivan Omar Lopez, an attorney licensed to practice law in Tennessee, alleging certain acts of misconduct. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 9, the Board of Professional Responsibility considered these matters at its meeting on September 9, 2011.

Through investigation of an overdraft of the Respondent's trust account, it was revealed that the Respondent regularly allowed clients to pay filing fees via a credit card payment service that deposited the money into his business account. The Respondent would then transfer the money to his trust account, but he did not always do so timely. In one case, the Respondent left the filing fee in his business account for a month before transferring the money to his trust account. In another case, the Respondent left money that a client had given him for the purpose of paying a traffic ticket in his business account for one week before transferring the money to his trust account. However, no client funds were adversely affected.

By comingling his own funds with those of his clients, Ivan Omar Lopez has violated Rule of Professional Conduct 1.15 (safekeeping property) and is hereby Publicly Censured for this violation.
